From Saturday, May 1, to Tuesday, May 4, 2010, the American Society of Hypertension convened in New York City its 25th Annual Scientific Meeting and Exposition. ISHIB was well represented in staff and membership throughout the meeting.

On Monday afternoon, Elijah Saunders, MD, FACC, FACP, primary investigator for the ISHIB IMPACT CV Risk Reduction Toolkit Study and an ISHIB founder, presented the ISHIB IMPACT CV Risk Reduction Toolkit Research Study: Study Design poster. Dr. Saunders' poster revealed the "tools" and study design while he fielded questions on this Baltimore-based study.

ISHIB Vice President David S.
Kountz, MD, MBA, chaired an ASH-ISHIB joint symposium, "Consensus Update to ISHIB Management Guidelines," based on the updated hypertension treatment and management guidelines pending publication. Writing group members Richard H. Grimm, MD, PhD, and Brent Egan, MD, ISHIB secretary/treasurer, joined lead author John Flack, MD, MPH, with presentations at this symposium.

The new guidelines are a critical component in the ISHIB IMPACT CV Risk Reduction Toolkit Study.



Legs for Life Summit in Baltimore

The ISHIB Diabetes and Obesity Consortium convened the first summit for the Legs for Life Toolkit Campaign 2010. Cochaired by Kwame Osei, MD, and James R. Gavin III, MD, PhD, the program boasted presentations from leaders in the community and field of diabetes patient care: Trudy Gaillard, PhD, RN; Rita Louard, MD, FACE; Lenore Coleman, PhD; Daniel Mullins, PhD; and Richard Horenstein, MD, JD.

The summit, held on May 8, 2010, in Baltimore, Maryland, was solely sponsored by Sanofi Aventis and also featured novel interventions from their Community Health Partnership (CHP) program.

Following presentations, attendees met in small groups to develop study design and tools for testing the Legs for Life hypothesis, which states; "Benefits of an intervention using evidencebased lifestyle changes plus ADA Guidelines with Ethnicity and Disease supplemental materials in a toolkit will be more effective than currently used treatment paradigms

in managing diabetes in racial and ethnic minorities, thus reducing healthcare disparities."
